

Text for the second page of the certificate of the General Preparatory Examination (Almen forberedelseeksamen)

The general adult education, cf. Act No. 603 of 23 May 2019 on General Adult Education aims to strengthen adults' opportunities for further education and to encourage their interest in education. The education is provided as single subject courses, leading to an examination according to national standards.

The general adult education aims to strengthen the students' professional insight, knowledge, skills and their critical faculties within general subjects. Through training the students shall acquire different ways of expressing themselves, oral as well as written, so they are enabled to communicate in a nuanced and targeted way. Various methods of working shall be employed, and the students' creative and innovative abilities shall be developed.

The teaching is based on intellectual freedom, equality and democracy. The teaching is organized so that students strengthen their qualifications for active participation in a democratic society. The training must help the students to act with their knowledge and attitudes in a local as well as a global context.

It is possible to complete a course programme with the General Preparatory Examination, which entitles the student to have a right of access to the 2-year Higher Preparatory Examination courses. The examination must be composed to include the following 5 subjects: Danish or Danish as a second language, English, mathematics (all level D) and also science plus one of the subjects history, social science studies, German or French (at level G or higher).

The individual examination in each subject used in the General Preparatory Examination must be passed, ie. at least 02 mark according to the 7-point marking scale, cf. Act No. 262 of 20 March 2007 on the Marking Scale and Other Forms of Assessment.
